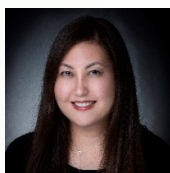

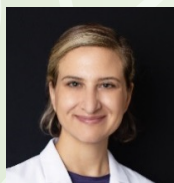

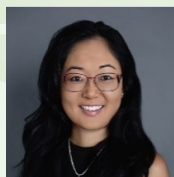

### Primary Care for Adults

We provide preventive and acute medical services, including:

- Physicals, sick visits, chronic disease management
- Laboratory services and screenings
- Health education and counseling

### Primary Care for Infants and Children

- Well-child checkups between 2 weeks and 3 years, and yearly after age 3
- Immunizations for school entry and sports physicals

### Women's Health and OB-GYN Care

- Pre- and post-natal care, including ultrasounds and nutritional planning; annual exams and birth control
- Testing and treatment for STDs

### Men's Health

- Comprehensive wellness services to optimize men's health
- Health screenings and annual exams

Our in-house pharmacy provides medication management, pill pouch packaging, free medication delivery on Oahu, and financial assistance for patients.

### Insurance

We accept all forms of insurance, including AlohaCare, HMSA, UnitedHealthcare, HMAA, Ohana Health Plan, UHA, Tricare Select, Medicare, Medicaid and other private insurance. If you do not have insurance, we can assist with enrollment and provide discounted services on a sliding fee scale.

If you do not have insurance, please bring ONE of the following for income verification:

- Recent pay stub
- Tax return
- Unemployment registration
- Proof of Department of Human Services benefits
- Proof of Temporary Assistance for Needy Families

Plus ONE item to verify identity:

- Driver's license
- State ID
- Passport or green card
