Cynthia Copp, APRN, Pediatric Nurse Practitioner, PNP Certification

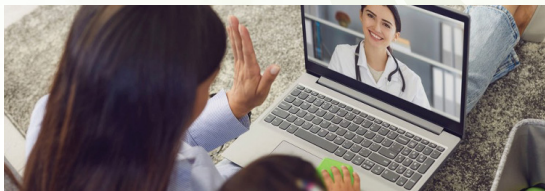

Patient Safety
