Primary Care for Adults

We provide preventive and acute medical services, including:

- Physicals, sick visits, chronic disease management
- Laboratory services and screenings
- Health education and counseling

Primary Care for Infants and Children

- Well-child checkups between 2 weeks and 3 years, and yearly after age 3
- Immunizations for school entry and sports physicals

Women's Health and OB-GYN Care

- Pre- and post-natal care, including ultrasounds and nutritional planning; annual exams and birth control
- Testing and treatment for STDs

Men's Health

- Comprehensive wellness services to optimize men's health
- Health screenings and annual exams
