The Wahiawā Health Pharmacy is a non-profit, 340B pharmacy exclusively for our patients to provide medication management, prescription accuracy and convenience.

Pharmacy services for our patients include:

- Free medication delivery on Oahu
- Free pill pouching packing that organizes medications by date and time
- Comprehensive medication management
- Financial assistance to help you afford your prescription medications
- Education programs including:
 - Diabetes Prevention and Self-Management
 - Hypertension Education
 - Quit Tobacco Program
- COVID-19 Testing and Vaccines

What is a 340B Pharmacy?

Congress created the 340B program to help uninsured and low-income patients gain better access to affordable prescription medications. Drug manufacturers are required to provide outpatient drugs at a reduced price to Federally Qualified Health Centers, like Wahiawā Health.

All profits received by our pharmacy go directly back into our health center to support jobs, programs and community outreach services that are often free to our community members.

Pharmacy RxSafe® Automation

Wahiawā Health's in-house pharmacy uses an RxSafe automated drug dispensing system called PakMyMedsTM that organizes prescription medications in individual pouches rather than pill bottles. The pouches are easy to open and labeled in large print with the date and time to be taken.
