Pharmacy RxSafe® Automation

 Wahiawā Health's in-house pharmacy uses an RxSafe automated drug dispensing system called PakMyMeds™ that provides prescription accuracy and simplifies taking medications.

PakMyMeds organizes prescription medications into individual pouches labeled with the intended date and time to be taken.

 For patients with multiple prescriptions, the RxSafe medication dispensing improves patient safety and health outcomes.

Diabetes Specialty Center Services

- Wahiawā Health's diabetes management team provides education to its diabetes patients to help improve their quality of life, self-manage their illness and reduce medical costs. Services include:
- Diabetes screening, diagnosis, prevention and evaluation.
- Improved health through recommended lifestyle changes, patient education, nutrition counseling and dietary management.
- Lowering A1c levels, blood pressure & cholesterol.
- Monitoring blood glucose levels.
- Physical activity guidance.
- Weight and stress management.
- Monitoring of oral medications and, if required, insulin use.
- Care for special populations including kūpuna.

Clinical Pharmacist Provides Patients with:

- A comprehensive medication management session via Telehealth and in-person visits.
- Free medication delivery to the patients' home.
- Screening for depression and/or stress and referral to our clinical psychologist or psychiatric nurse practitioner for mental health care.
- Glucometers and blood pressure cuffs provided by the American Heart Association to monitor hypertension.

Community Health Outreach

- Wahiawā Health's community health outreach team helps address challenging barriers in the community and enhances medical care access by:
 - Helping set up transportation to medical appointments.
 - Delivering medications.
 - Connecting patients to resources such as food, housing, hygiene supplies.

Behavioral Therapy

- Our team of behavioral therapists utilize several methods to help patients understand thoughts that negatively impact their behavior.
- Benefits of behavioral therapy can give people hope about their condition, improve self-esteem, help them relax and develop a more rational thought process.
- Patients can learn to become more self-reliant and responsible for change, building self-confidence and help increase participation in their diabetes treatment.
